

How-To Submit UNA Immunization Requirements

• Go to the UNA website: <u>www.una.edu</u> and Click "Quick links" at the top of the page




• Next, click Health Services




• Click on "Submit Immunization" and log in with your UNA credentials




- Click arrows to drop down each immunization box. Enter Dates for each immunization. Dates should match your immunization record.
- Remember: Titer dates and results will only be entered if you do not have immunization dates and get bloodwork done to satisfy the requirements.
 - For example; If you have had the MMR vaccines, you will enter the vaccine dates for dose 1 and dose 2 and leave the measles titer, the mumps titer, and the rubella titer spaces blank.




Next, click the submit button to save the information entered.



• Follow the instructions on the pop-up and click to access the upload screen. Follow the instructions to upload your immunization record.




 Scroll down and click the down arrow to select what documentation you are submitting, then click select file to choose the file from your phone or computer.



• Click the upload button to complete this process. You can view your documentation by clicking on "view file"



• Next, click the Forms tab in the Patient Portal to complete the TB Questionnaire and the UNA Medical History form.



- The Immunization Exemption Request form can be filled out for medical and religious exemptions. TB Questionnaire & UNA Medical History Forms are still required.
- The Past Positive TB Skin Test Questionnaire can be filled out if you have had a past positive and are unable to take a TB Skin Test.
- UNA Privacy Policy Acknowledgment and UNA Release Authorization are required for Health Services clinic appointments, but are not required for the immunization requirements

• Health Services' staff will review the documentation and will verify compliance and may send an email with additional instructions. On the immunization tab in the patient portal, <u>Compliant</u>, <u>Verified</u> is shown when all immunization requirements are complete.
