Incoming nurse practitioner students who receive this grant will have a large portion of tuition paid along with additional smaller benefits, such as learning aids to prepare for the workforce. Along with a small stipend each academic year for the duration of their FNP education. Additionally, they will have an FNP review course paid for prior to taking their boards.

- Increasing the number of nurse practitioner students who train for practice in rural and/or underserved areas
- Increase diversity in the healthcare workforce
- Build and support existing partnerships that will increase experiential learning opportunities in rural and/or underserved areas
- Students must choose/be placed with clinical preceptors in rural areas or underserved populations
- Additional requirements such as mentoring, monthly meetings with the program coordinator, tutoring if necessary, etc will apply
