The Psychology Department Goes Abroad

This past summer Drs. Ryan Zayac, Larry Bates, and Gabriela Carrasco from the Department of Psychology led 13 students on a study abroad program to Austria, Germany, and Switzerland. The program focused on the History of Psychology and the Psychology of Good and Evil. Students also collaborated with the faculty on research examining the impacts of a cultural scavenger hunt on the development of intercultural competence. Trip highlights included a tour of the Reichstag (home to the German parliament), visiting the University of Leipzig - location of psychology's modern founding, completing the cultural scavenger hunt with local students and faculty at the University of Wurzburg, exploring Sigmund Freud's home and museum in Vienna, and touring the United Nations in Geneva.
