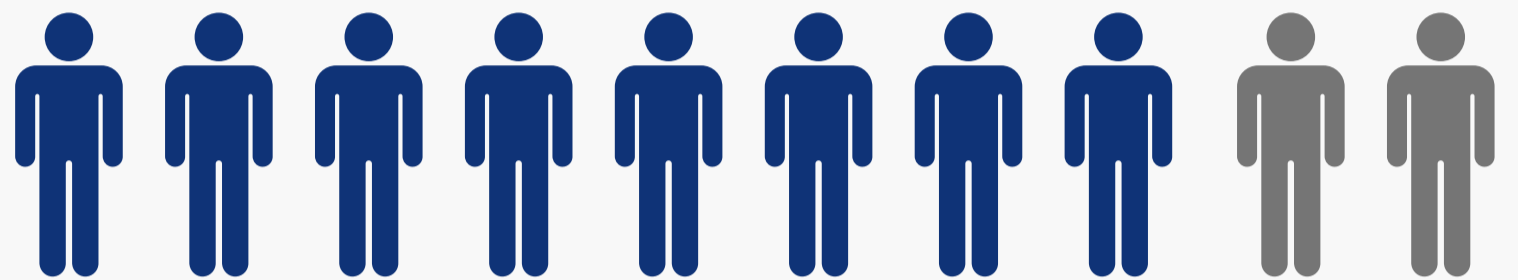

A PROMISING FUTURE

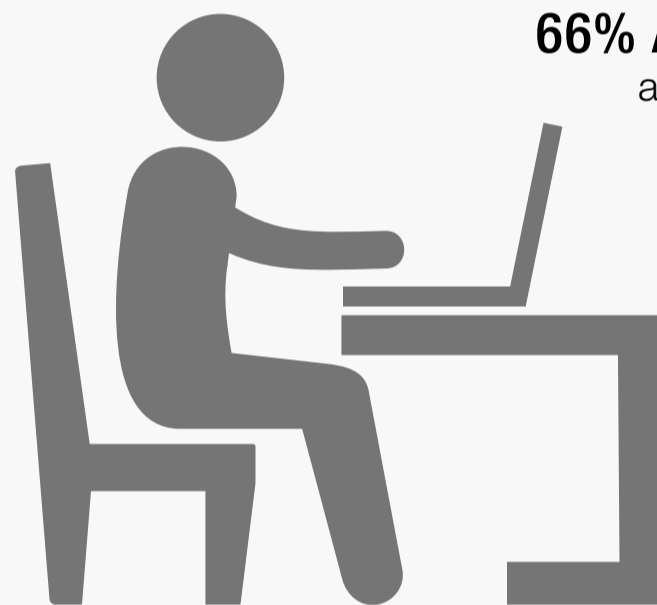
Alumni agree—AmeriCorps made a difference in advancing their career.¹



- 55% FIGURED OUT THEIR NEXT STEPS in terms of educational goals
- 64% FIGURED OUT THEIR NEXT STEPS in terms of career/professional goals
- 79% OF AMERICORPS ALUMNI ARE SATISFIED OR VERY SATISFIED with their career path after service



8 OUT OF 10 SAY AMERICORPS BENEFITED AND ADVANCED THEIR CAREER PATH



66% ARE EMPLOYED WITHIN 6 MONTHS after completing their AmeriCorps commitment

42% FOUND EMPLOYMENT due to an AmeriCorps connection

A Tuft's University study found that resumes listing AmeriCorps were 7% MORE LIKELY TO GET A CALL BACK for an interview than those without²

Alumni show a significant, sustained impact in life satisfaction and feel their service was worthwhile.³

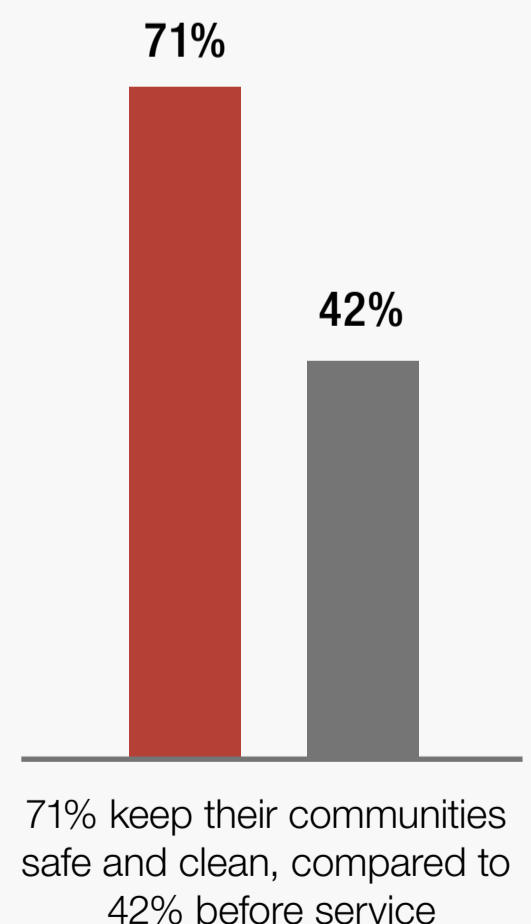


90% OF ALUMNI FEEL THEY IMPROVED THEIR ABILITY TO SOLVE PROBLEMS

94% OF ALUMNI FEEL THEY BROADENED THEIR UNDERSTANDING OF SOCIETY AND DIFFERENT COMMUNITIES

91% OF ALUMNI FEEL THEY MADE A CONTRIBUTION TO THE COMMUNITY

92% OF ALUMNI FEEL THEY MADE A DIFFERENCE IN THE LIFE OF AT LEAST ONE PERSON
