## Interim E-business minutes, April 3<sup>rd</sup> through 16<sup>th</sup>, 2009

On April 3<sup>rd</sup> the Faculty Senate President emailed faculty the proposed constitutional amendments with a link and brief instructions on voting through SurveyMonkey with a deadline of April 15<sup>th</sup>. At close of business on April 15<sup>th</sup> the votes were:

Amendment 1:	For	169	90.9%
	Against	13	7.0%
	Abstain	4	2.2%

Total Response Rate 186 of 269 = 69.1%

Amendment 2: For 146 80.2% Against 29 15.9% Abstain 4 3.8%

Total response Rate 182 of 269 = 67.7%

Both amendments were passed with at least 2/3 of the faculty responding (present) for each amendment and with at least a 2/3 majority of those voting doing so "for" each amendment.
