AHEC Scholars will learn in interprofessional teams, completing didactic and clinical training alongside their professional academic programming while preparing to work with Alabama's high-demand populations, particularly in rural and economically challenged regions.

The two-year commitment consists of 40 hours of online training and 40 hours of team-based service learning per year.

 - Optometry
 - Pharmacy
 - Nurse Practitioner
 - Nurse Midwife
- One-page personal statement
- An interview with a regional coordinator
