- VII. SPECIAL BUSINESS
 - Speaker Mr. Jay Cochran
 - He was talking about the Pine Street renovations.
 - All three senates passed a resolution to help with public safety on Pine Street.
 - Many years ago, the city did a Pine Street safety study.
 - That study recommended to go down to two lanes with a middle turn lane, but it was pretty expensive.
 - The city and UNA had a meeting, and the total price is around \$3 million and some of it will be handled by a grant and that will be for sidewalks. The rest will be about \$2 million to turn it into 2 lanes and a turn lane. The city and the university are splitting it 50/50.
 - There has been a couple of pedestrian incidents in the past couple of years.
 - The sidewalk portion will stop at the College Street Church of Christ.
 - Hopefully the sidewalks will be six feet wide or maybe eight feet to meet ADA standards.
 - It will work well on gamedays and on academic days.

- He showed us the purple crosswalks drawing. Hopefully all of the crosswalks will slow down traffic and there will be signals.
- They have been speaking with Congressman Aderholt about beautifying the area, and Aderholt wants to help improve this project with medians and trees and making it look nicer and have a campus feel.
- Another part of this project is pedestrian lighting up and down the crosswalks.
- They are working on a lighting solution for the bridge with engineers.
- Hopefully this will be done by next fall.
- They are trying to coordinate with the stadium.
- Hopefully they will start the bidding process for this project soon.
- They are hoping to expand parking on Pine Street.
- They have achieved in getting \$16 million from Washington D.C. and \$4 million from the state of Alabama for the engineering building and the goal is to build a parking deck on top of it.
- They are 99% there on this project and they will be announcing it soon.
- In the spring, there will be a lot of activity with the project.
- The road will not be completely out of use so it should not be a total disruption.
- They told them that if they can add additional parking, they will try to add it, and maybe additional parking at Kilby parking lot.
- In six years, we have gotten over a \$100 million for advancements to the campus.
- He says to let them know if you have any fun ideas to make campus better.
- This renovation fully developed will completely change the aesthetic and make it feel like it is more a part of campus.
