STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT Bill 24-16

- I. This Act shall be known and cited as the Medici Oversight Accord.
- II. The purpose of this bill is to add two additional lines to the Code of Laws numbered 604.4 and 604.4.1. The purpose of line 604.4 is to allow Budget Oversight and Allocations committee members to attend events funded by allocations while maintaining a system of checks and balances over its members. This system operates under the oversight of the president, pro tempore, and SGA advisor. The purpose of line 604.4.1 is to institutionalize an ethical policy; Budget Oversight and Allocation meeting participants abstaining from voting on requests from RSOs they are members of in hopes of avoiding misuse of allocations funding.
- III. There is no current legislation for 604.4 and 604.4.1
- IV. 604.4 shall now read:

SGA members who serve on the Budget Oversight and Allocations committee and who would like to attend a function that has received allocations as students instead of working SGA members must obtain prior approval from a panel comprised of the SGA president and SGA pro-tempore of the Senate. If this panel cannot decide, the decision will fall to the SGA advisor.

604.4.1 shall now read:

Any participant of a Budget Oversight and Allocations meeting is required to abstain from voting on allocations submitted by organizations they are members of.

V. This bill will become law upon ratification by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Senate and the subsequent approval of the Student Government Association President and Vice President.
