A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- I. This Act shall be known and cited as The Trainings Removal Act.
- II. Due to the fact that mandatory trainings are no longer an option for SGA due to Alabama Act 2024-34 (formerly known as SB-129), it is proposed that Sections 9,10, and 11 in chapter 200 are removed in order to make it so that Mandatory Trainings are no longer required.
- III. Chapter 200.9 currently Reads:
SGA Senators and Executive Council members are required to attend mandatory training every semester including: Diversity and Inclusion training once per semester with the office of Division of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (ODEI) and Leadership or Team Building training once per semester.

Chapter 200.10 currently reads:
The Executive Council members are required to attend: One (1) additional Diversity and Inclusion training per semester and One (1) additional Leadership or Team Building training per semester.

Chapter 200.11 currently reads:
Failure to participate in required semester trainings will result in an absence per training not completed. Semester trainings must be completed at least two (2) weeks prior to final examinations each semester. Trainings are to be set up and scheduled by the executive council. If a senator or executive council member is absent during one of the scheduled trainings, it is the responsibility of the senator or executive council member to attend a training session on their own time. Email documentation from the training leader of attendance must be submitted to the SGA Secretary no later than one week after completion of the make-up training.
- IV. Now it shall read: There will be no legislation regarding this topic in the Code of Laws.
- V. This bill will become law upon ratification by two--thirds (2/3) vote of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Senate and the subsequent approval of the Student Government Association President and Vice President.
