X. CHAIR REPORTS

- Academic Affairs Chairwoman McMahan
 - They have been discussing goals, initiatives and Code of Laws changes.
 - She had people vote on a name for their initiative.
 - They met with the Student Success Center to help with their initiative.
 - Their initiative will start February 1st.
 - Her committee will start to write bills for the Code of Laws.
- Budget Oversight Chairman McCuiston
 - They met and they had eleven requests. There were six approved, three required modifications and two were denied.

- Elections and Recruitment Chairwoman Vezina
 - She has sent a lot of emailing and graphic requests forms.

- Constitutional compliance

- Bill 26-03: Scholarship and Salary Clarification Act
 - Chairwoman McDonald went over the bill.
 - Senator Moore says there should be clarification of the fall and spring semester since they only get paid during fall and spring.
 - There was an amendment to adding a 404.3.10, and the amendment was not accepted.
 - There was a motion to table this bill and it was tabled.
- Bill 26-04: No Exec for Exec Act
 - Freshman Forum Advisor Buford explains that the executive chair from this year and last year did not find it beneficial to be at executive council meetings.
 - Vice President Ballenger agrees with this bill.
 - Senator Anthony thinks this is a great bill and has past experience with the information of this bill.
 - President Rhoades says it's a great bill.
 - The bill passes.
- Bill 26-05: One is a Must Act
 - This is to be in compliance with the Code of Laws that one Freshman Forum Advisor must be at attendance of executive council meetings.
 - Freshman Forum Advisor Ebert says that it is a great bill, and we have to pass it to be in compliance.
